# 1. OPEN ACCESS COMPUTER LABS

## 1.1 LOCATIONS AND EXPECTED AVAILABILITY OF OPEN ACCESS COMPUTER LABORATORIES

The Open Access facilities are available for use by all Victoria University students. Some faculties also have laboratories open between classes for students to use.

Computer laboratories, printers and photocopiers are usually very busy when assignments are due so you may not be able to get access to a computer when you want it. You need to allow extra time to be sure of completing your work on time. Make sure you organise your workload so that your assessment deadlines are achievable.

The Student Managed Operating Environment (MOE) is installed on all Open Access Computer Laboratories throughout the University. The MOE includes the following applications:
